Because the longer we wait for the main infrastructure to be in place, hundreds of children are deprived of their right to education, and time does not wait for them. It moves.

Affording them their right to education becomes paramount, even in temporary structures.

However, there is a requirement which can never be wished away, or temporalised: water.



Mostly for health reasons, even a temporary school requires water.

We were therefore in celebratory mood when we finally found water on our premises. The process itself was satisfying, with our founder, Nancy Mbaura actually taking part in the search!

Now, our borehole is fully functional, watering our determination to one day having the best boarding school in the country.

With water, that determination is guaranteed growth.
